All students must choose one subject **from each** of the four option blocks below. Each option has 8 hours of study over a fortnight. There is also one hour of compulsory PSHE and one hour of careers education. Students will have a total of 34 hours over a fortnight leaving 16 hours of independent study time in the sixth form centre.

Look at the complete list of subjects across **boxes A, B, C and D** and indicate in each box what you would like as your **first and second choice**. For example, write a 1 against the subject you would most like to take, and a 2 against your next preferred choice. <u>The reason for this is that while every effort is made to</u> <u>accommodate all first choices, occasionally some options will not be viable and will not run.</u>

We will do our best to match up courses to your first-choice preferences but this can not be guaranteed in every instance. Also, it is worth reminding you at this point that choosing an option does not automatically guarantee entry into the examination at the end of the course. This is dependent on your hard work and readiness for the exam.

PATHWAYS:

There are three pathways open to St John's students in our sixth form and these will be dependent on your GCSE examination results. You will be interviewed before starting the sixth form to ensure you are on the right course for you. We reserve the right to refuse entry to courses when students do not have the suitable grades to meet the demands of the course.

As a general guide:

Pathway 1: A levels (or A levels and BTEC combined)

5 GCSEs at grade 5 or above including English and Mathematics. (Some courses will require grade 6 or above to ensure students are able to cope with the demands of the A level course.)

Pathway 2: BTEC only

5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and Maths

Pathway 3: NVQ

No minimum entry requirements

Students can also re-take GCSE Maths and/or English if necessary
